During the virtual season, how does the situational cue portion work?

The event host will provide each registered coach the assigned situational cue. The cue is provided Sunday of event week. The coach, or designated person, should read the cue at the appropriate time during the performance.

Is there a non-building division?

No, not for game day. Game day is separated into three divisions: High School Tumbling, High School Non-Tumbling, and Rec Game Day.

Is building allowed during game day divisions?

Yes, if you are cleared and approved to stunt. The specific stunting category has been removed from the score sheets for this season only. All stunting skills will be scored under "incorporation of skills." This category will score stunts, jumps, kicks, and tumbling elements to level the playing field.

Are we required to build during game day divisions, and will we be penalized if we do not?

No, you are not required to build during the virtual season. No penalty or loss of a score. Stunting categories have been removed for this season only.
