- Must have the ability to work in a cooperative and harmonious manner to be part of a school-wide athletic program.
- Ability to lead the direction of the Green squad in sync with the overall direction and goals of the White Squad and IBW cheer as a whole.
- Support Head coach when necessary.
- Long term time commitment: Tryouts in June, and regular season August-March.
 - Attending weeknight practices and games as well as weekend competitions.
- Strong communication skills.
